


## Fishing Lures

- 1. Cut blanks to size. 1"  $\times$  1"  $\times$  5" is a good average size. Blanks can be most any wood but western red cedar mahogany or maple work well.
- 2. If making a popper, make an angled cut on one end.




- 2. Drill 1/8 in hole through the center of the blank using a long bit. This can be done using a Jacobs chuck on your lathe or a drill press if the throw is long enough.
- 3. Mount blank between centers.
- 4. Turn to shape and sand.
- 5. Apply one or more coats of sanding sealer.
- 6. Paint as desired
- 7. Add hardware





- Run leader through plug and attach hook
- Add hooks to belly, if desired
- Add spinners, beads, etc.
